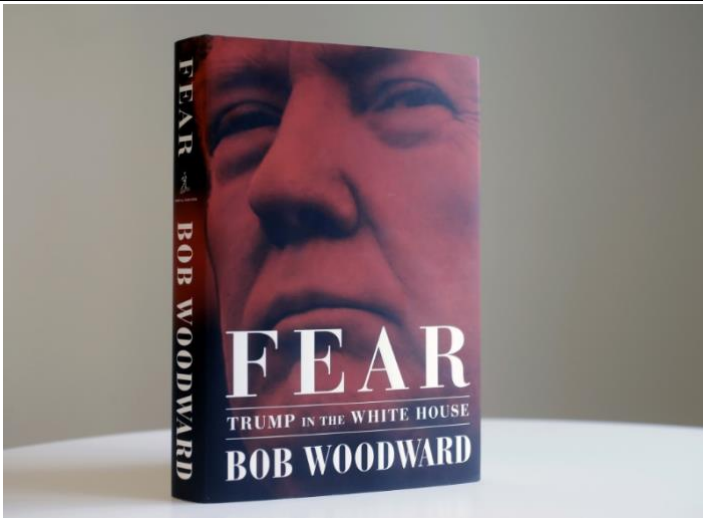
A Note of Caution
